Provides anatomic and clinical pathology specimen services as scheduled by the Chief of the Department. Performs services in embedded tissues, prepares paraffin blocks for cutting on rotary microtome; attaches tissue on specifically prepared slides. Clears paraffin from tissue, performs routine and special stains. Maintains histopathology records and instruments; maintains complete records of all surgical, cytological and autopsy specimens.

Biomedical Equipment Maintenance Technician

Independently performs a wide range of calibration and/or preventive maintenance and repair on medical equipment throughout associate units. Responsible for verifying calibration of equipment while identifying malfunctioning medical equipment to troubleshoot for preventive maintenance or to install replacement parts as required.

Podiatrist

Performs comprehensive outpatient and surgical podiatric care services to examine, diagnose and treat diseases and injuries of the foot by operative and non-operative means. Provides evaluation and treatment of emergent, urgent, and nonemergent patients. Administers monthly peer reviews, maintains statistical records of clinical workload and participates in medical education programs. Serves in an advisory and teaching capacity on an "as required" basis for Family Health Physicians and Physician Assistant student training. Prescribes prescriptions guided by the Medical Treatment Facility formulary.

Otolaryngologist

Caregiver; diagnose and manage diseases of the ears, nose, sinuses, larynx, mouth and throat, as well as structures of the neck and face. Performs complex inpatient and outpatient a surgical procedures.

Gastroenterolgy Nurse (RN)

Diagnose and treat patients experiencing problems with their digestive system and gastrointestinal tract; diagnose conditions such as cancer and reflux. Provides instruction to patients on how to manage their symptoms in their daily life. In the case of extreme conditions, assists physicians in surgical procedures.
